A message from the President

In one of my first meetings with LA5, I recall that Bruce Murdoch made an announcement on behalf of the Children's Court Committee inviting Rotarians to chaperone foster kids at a day at Disneyland. What a fun idea. This joyful outing demonstrated LA5's heart for young people. As I have learned, that caring goes back many years and includes our Club's transformative work with the Edleman's Children's Court.

LA5's interest in this work is not surprising. The facts surrounding the LA County foster care system are heartbreaking. 30,000 children are currently in foster care in Los Angeles County and 1400 are awaiting adoptive families. Only 58% of young people in foster care graduate from high school and only 3% graduate from college. Half of all young adults who age out of foster care end up homeless or incarcerated.

These are but just a few of the reasons why we are dedicating LA5's 2020 Community Grants Day to helping organizations who support children in the foster care system. We have committed to distribute at least \$100,000 to these organizations at a special lunch program on April 17 called, Families are Forever. I hope that you will make every effort to get involved in this effort. What is your claim to fame?


My culinary skills are amazing. I work had to ensure I only use the freshest, locally grown produce and choice meats and seafood. And then there's the method.


