#### A MESSAGE FROM THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Dear Fellow Rotarians,

### BEIRUT RELIEF FUND




On August 4, the city of Beirut, Lebanon was rocked by a devastating explosion. The death toll is still climbing and thousands have been injured.


